## Kashmir Files- A Political Issue

The head of the jury of 53rd International Film Fest of India at Goa, A Israeli film maker 'Nadav Lapido' has slammed the controversial film, 'The Kashmiri Files' which revolves around the killing and exodus of Kashmiri Pandits in 1990 from Kashmir Valley. He used very strong words saying that the movie is Propaganda and he called it a Vulgar Film. Later, Sudipto Sen maintains the remark made by Nadav Lapido on 'The Kashmiri Files' that it is his personal opinion and not that of the entire jury's opinion.

The movie has also been banned by Singapore government. They gave their statement, "The film will be refused classification for its provocative and one sided portrayal of Muslims and the depiction of Hindus being persecuted in the ongoing conflict in Kashmir".

The Indian government played a very strong role in the movie controversy.

The movie was made tax free in many of the BJP states to encourage people to watch the movie. Critics state "BJP used Kashmir Files to blame Congress for the exodus of the Kashmiri Pandits". Mehbooba Mufti ,the former Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir has criticized the government for promoting the film, she states "The manner in which Government Of India is aggressively promoting 'The Kashmir Files' and is weaponing the pain of Kashmiri Pandits makes their ill intention obvious. Instead of healing old wounds and creating a conducive atmosphere between the two communities, they are deliberately tearing them apart".

Accordingly in the movie, Muslims are portrayed as uniformly evil, treacherous and predatory. Even little Muslim boys are shown as Demonic. Hindu women are depicted as being envied and greatly desired by lustful Muslim men. This has been ruining re-

lationships between Hindu-Muslim communities.

The movie has made Indian Muslims fearful. The movie has unintentionally disrespected Islamic Religion. Indian Muslims asked for the harmony of the nation.

The Film was not expected to collect much at the box office but it became one of the highest grossing movie in Bollywood in 2022. The film collected more than 300 CR Worldwide.




# Was “Therapy session” by NF a flop before it release?

**T**herapy session a Dark Christian hip-hop and motivation album, where the artist Nathan John Feuerstein shares his own experience and every song has a story and the title song “Therapy Session” was a blast in this album. This was a successful album after the release of “Mansion”. And an underrated artist was in an unstoppable rise in his career, everyone thought that this artist won’t come up and his talent is not enough, but this album release proved everyone wrong.

The Studio Album by NF got a four star review at CCM Magazine, Matt Conner writes, “fortunately NF digs deeper on an impressive second album.” David Craft, allotting the album three and a half stars from Jesus Freak Hideout, believes, “In no way is NF lacking in talent or creativity, but he could afford to exercise a tad more patience. This album doesn’t seem quite ready for release, evidenced by the short, one-year gap between Mansion and Therapy Session. Regardless, NF has blown past

the sophomore slump, creating a project well-worth listening to.” Awarding the album four and a half stars at Jesus Freak Hideout, Kevin Hoskins writes, “Many are not going to like the pure raw emotions here, but I am a fan of someone who can offer something outside of the box and this fits that bill perfectly.” Mark Rice, rating the album three and a half stars for Jesus Freak Hideout, states, “Personally, I’m ambivalent towards NF’s approach, but it makes for a good, thoughtful, and memorable listen. I do hope, however, for NF’s sake, that he experiences some personal growth before his next dark excursion isn’t necessary.”

Giving the album four stars from Jesus Freak Hideout, Lucas Munachen describes, “Therapy Session, is a strong step forward and delves into even darker themes. Therapy Session may be one of the year’s most memorable rap albums, but I have a feeling it only scratches the surface of NF’s talent.” Christopher Smith, allocating the album a four

star review for Jesus Freak Hideout, believes, “Therapy Session is a rewarding and refreshingly honest listen if you can embrace it “where”. The solid bars, simplistic yet cinematic production, and honest songwriting make this a solid and memorable sophomore release.” Haley Black, indicating in a four out of five review at Highlight Magazine, says, “He bellows powerfully, building momentum, projecting his path as a musician and reliving the “judgements” that his career is meaningless.” Signaling in a 4.5 out of five review for Reel Gospel, Carlin Doyle states, “dark and intense, but real.” Chris Major, rating the album a 4.9 out of five, writes, “Therapy Session addresses the grief, regret, and anger stockpiled in Mansion, hitting home with NF’s intense lyrics and undisputed honesty.”

David Jeffries of Allmusic gave the album 4 out of 5 stars, praising the album for its “theatrical production” and described the album as “chock-full of raw emotions and honesty”. Commercial performance:

“Therapy Session” debuted at number 12 on the Billboard 200 selling 29,184 album-equivalent units in the first week. It also charted at number 1 on the Christian Albums Chart and number 1 on the Rap Albums chart. As of October 2017, it sold 122,000 copies in the United States.

# Story of Inspiration

## Behind the success of The “One Man Army”

**N**iklas Christl is a famous YouTuber. He has more than 900 thousand subscribers on his YouTube channel by the name Niklas Christl. He hails from Munich, Bavaria, Germany. At the age of 18 he travelled the world and left his higher education to start A NEW LIFE. Where he learnt about various culture of the world and when he was in Australia, he worked as a waiter in a Restaurant for his travel expenses. He came to Germany in 2016 and got settled and worked as a Managing Partner at TalentSpy Executive Search in Munich, Germany.

Love for filmmaking & YouTube- At 12, Niklas got his first digital camera and thanks to this, he fell in love with filmmaking and he wanted to grow up to become a YouTuber. With that camera, he started filming random things like scuba diving, bike riding, and other things which interested him. At that time, Niklas also started watching YouTube videos and was attracted towards YouTube as a platform. He began by watching the videos of Sam Kolder and he considers him as one of his YouTube idols.

Education- Niklas did his school-

ing from Gymnasium Bruckmühl high school and finished his schooling in 2016. Even though he was very interested in learning filmmaking, he decided not to enroll into a university to learn it. He took this decision because he felt that a film school wouldn't teach him all the aspects of filmmaking. So, he started learning filmmaking on his own by watching YouTube videos and filming videos. For a while, he was also attracted towards landscape photography but later he shifted his focus to filmmaking.

Starting YouTube channels- In his adolescent years, He started a couple of YouTube channels. He used to publish funny videos on his first YouTube channel and later, he started another YouTube channel with his friend and started uploading sketches onto it. These channels couldn't perform well and later, Niklas made them private.

Working as an intern- Niklas worked as an intern at many organisations in order to better learn filmmaking. In July 2014, he worked as a student intern for Maritim Film GmbH. Then, from November 2017 to February 2018, He worked as an intern at KMS

BLACKSPACE Later, from May 2018 to August 2018, he worked as an intern for beech studios.

Working for Daniel Abt- While working as an intern at beech studios, Niklas applied for the position of content creator at Daniel Abt, an automotive YouTuber. Fortunately, he got selected and from September 2018, he started working for Daniel's YouTube channel by the name, Daniel Abt. Niklas moved from his hometown to Kempten in order to work for Daniel. While working here, he also got opportunities to work with brands like Audi Sport GmbH, Michelin, Schaeffler, etc. After working for around a year and a half, Niklas started losing interest in his job because his job involved filming cars but he wasn't passionate about cars. Also, he felt his job to be monotonous and fast-paced as his job required travelling to different countries rapidly. So, in March 2020, He quit his high-paying full-time job and decided to work full-time on his own YouTube channel and move to a foreign country. He was 22 at that time.

Working on his own YouTube channel- Niklas started his YouTube channel by the name Niklas Christl on

9 October 2017.

Even though he started publishing videos onto it from 22 February 2018 onwards, he fully focused on his channel only after quitting his full-time job. Peter McKinnon is one of his inspirations to work on YouTube. Initially, as He wasn't earning money with his videos, he undertook some freelance projects and worked with brands like Mercedes-Benz, etc. Eventually, as his YouTube channel grew and became financially viable, he fully focused on his channel and stopped taking freelance projects.

Struggles- Niklas faced many difficulties on his path of becoming a successful YouTuber, like COVID affected his travel plans and also negatively affected his earnings as he couldn't secure sufficient freelance proj-

ects due to COVID. Also, once, he had to leave his apartment in Kempten and move to his hometown to live at his mother's home.

Becoming viral- Niklas's first video to get viral is titled- DJI Mavic Air 2 | Cinematic HDR Footage. This video was published on 28 May 2020. Apart from his YouTube channel, Niklas also has an online shop through which he sells LUTs and Presets. In 2021, he moved from Germany to Cape Town, South Africa and in June 2022, he moved to Bali, Indonesia.




**Describe yourself in one word?** I would say “balanced” because I balance everything and move on and work hard. I was introvert at first and completely trans-


formed into extrovert and explorer and I have balanced modeling, youtube, singing, dancing and everything and you need balance in your life and it should be your first priority.
