





The mission and vision of RELA are to support citizen empowerment for better electoral democracy participation through voluntary registration, ethical voting, and the creation of a democratic system.

By fostering an atmosphere that encourages participation in Free and Fair elections, RELA is convinced that the action plan will be carried out efficiently to increase electoral registration and voter turnout.

The purpose of RELA is to increase voter participation in general elections and the Byatarayanapura Constituency in particular. The curriculum created by the aforementioned association continuously focuses on enhancing and inspiring eligible voters and potential voters for the political process.

Objectives:

- 1. Through RELA, the University aims at strengthening the culture of electoral participation among young and future voters.
- 2. To educate the targeted populations about voter registration, electoral process and related matters through hands on experience.


Here is the proposal for a list of activities for the Voting Awareness Program
