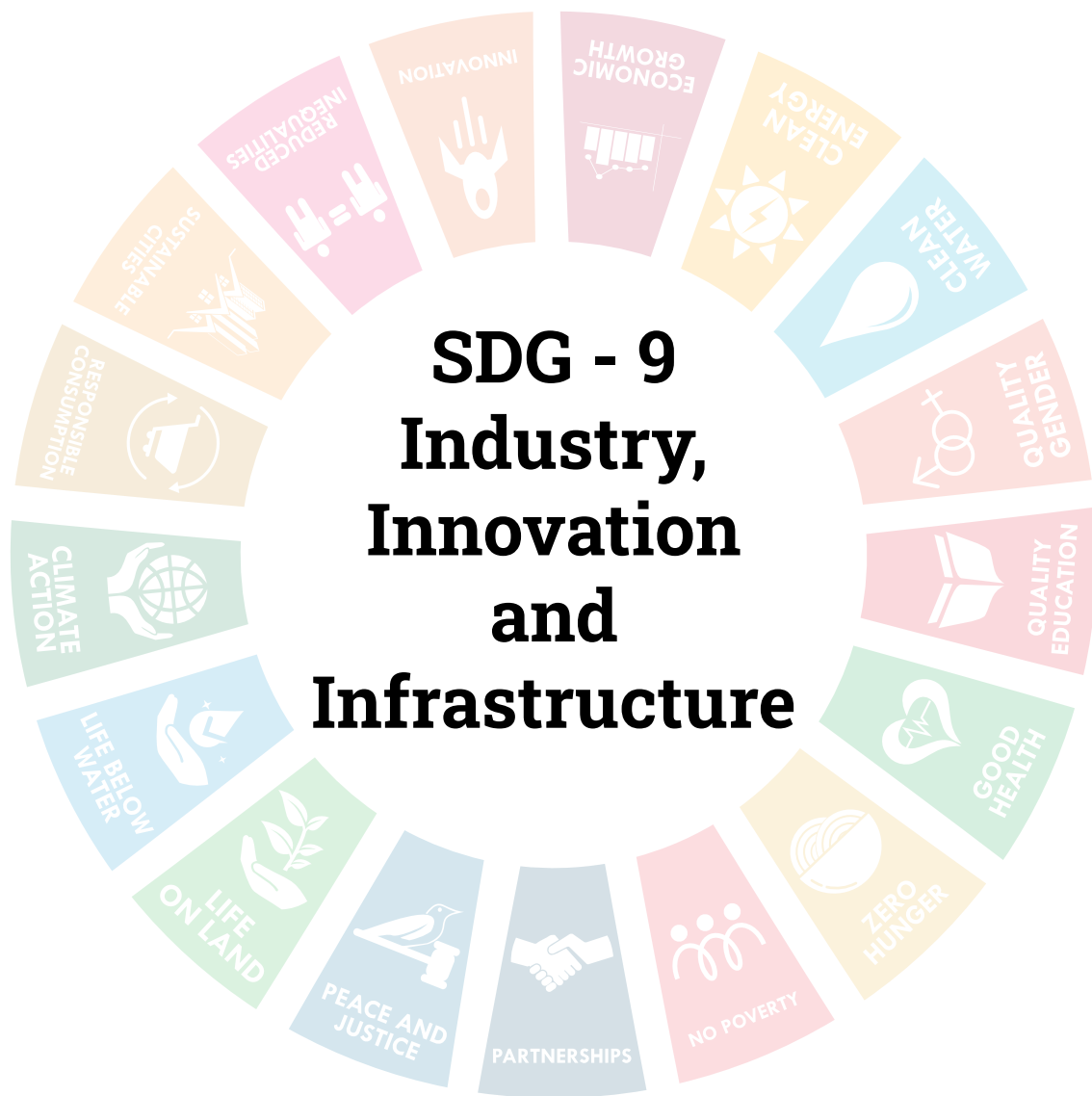

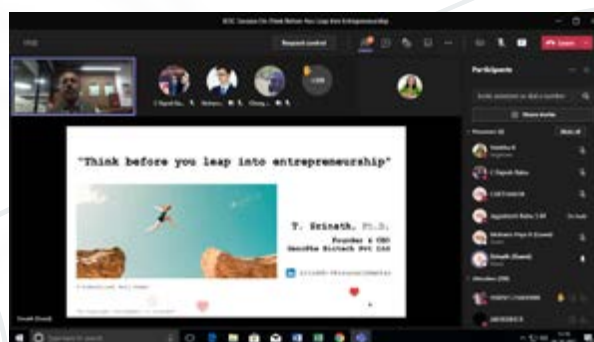

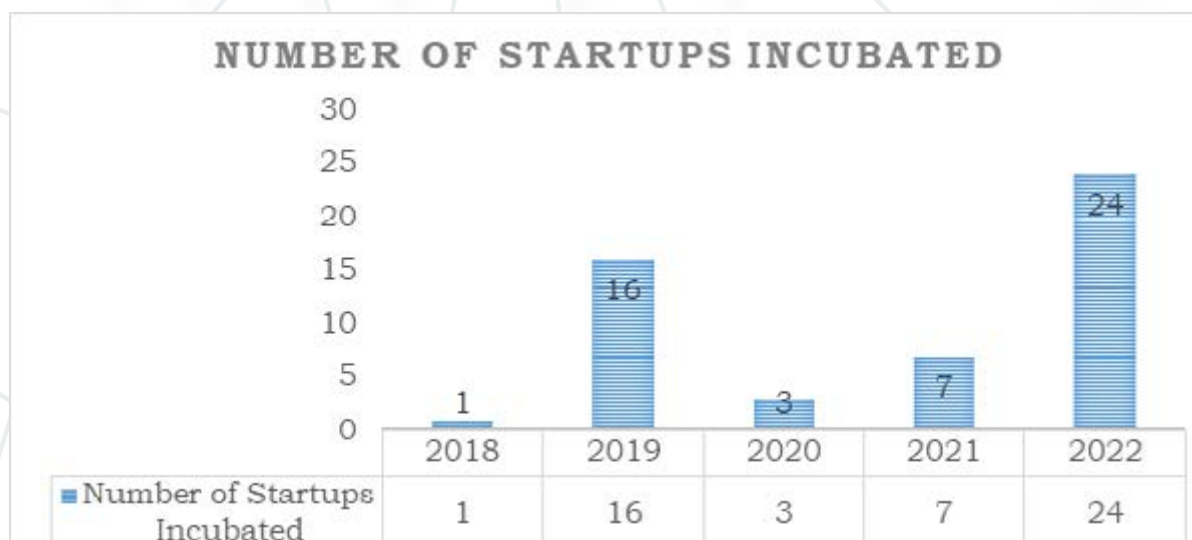


• **Incubation Center – REVA NEST**

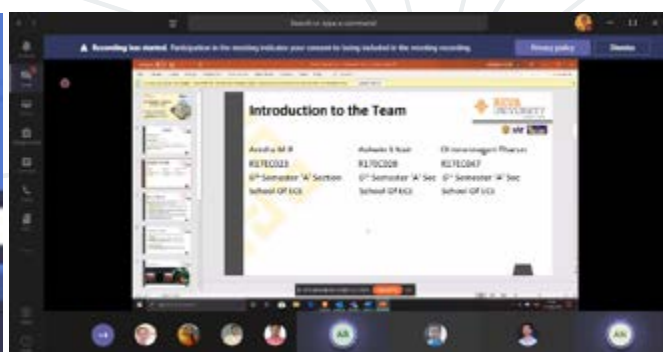


University Industry Interaction Centre (UIIC), REVA University successfully Organized Pitch Day for Start-up Companies on 10th June 2019.
