# 74<sup>th</sup> Independence Day 2022

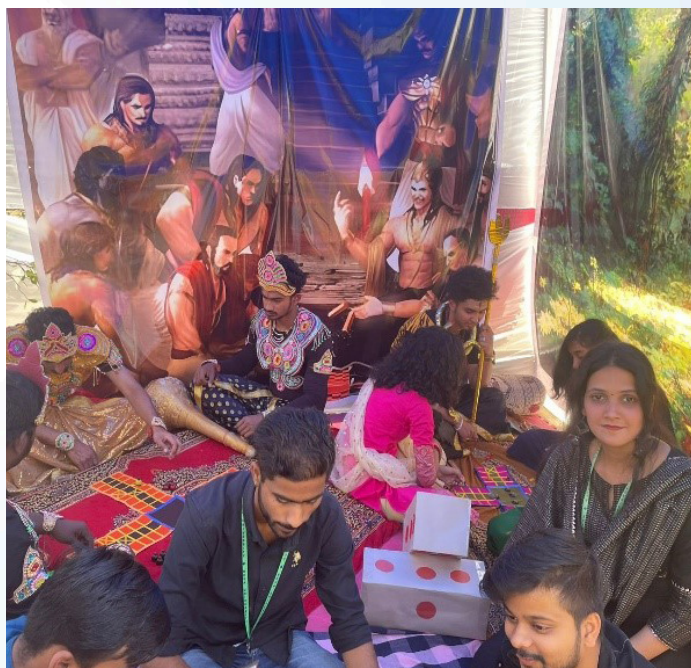

### REVA Business School's new block inaugurated

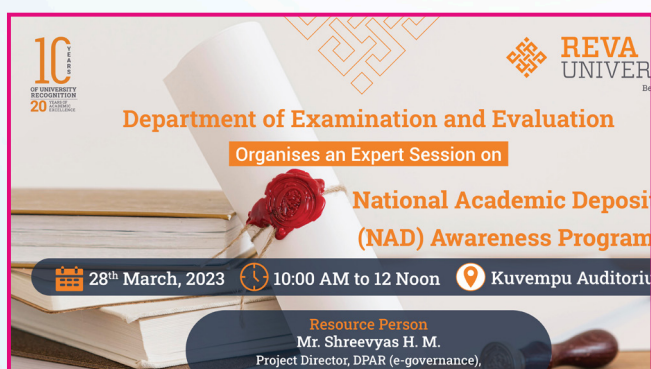

## Videography Workshop

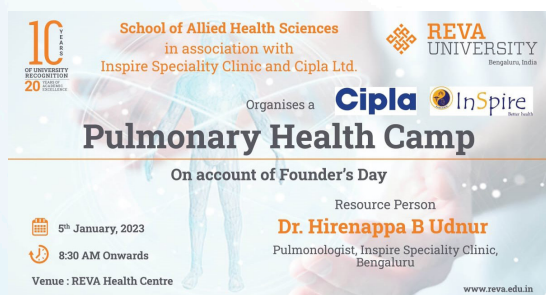

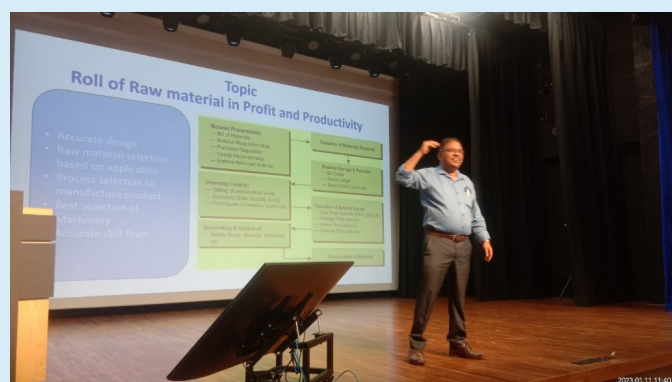

## Outreach Activity

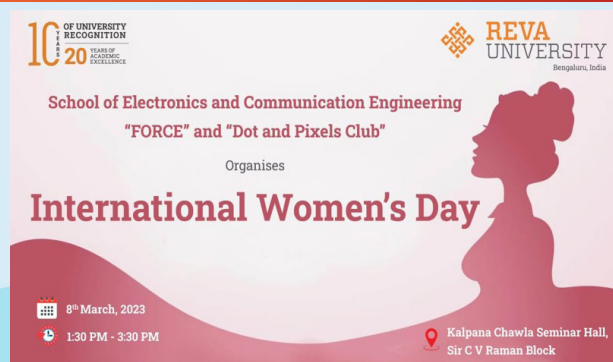

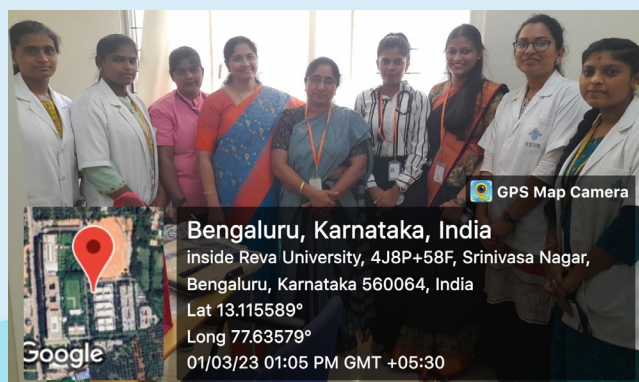
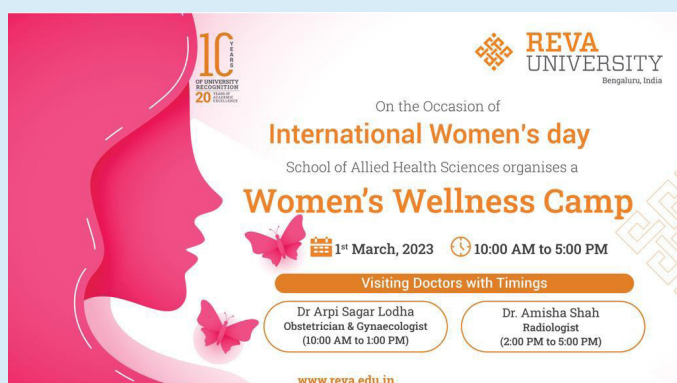
## RBS Distinguished Lecture Series – Dr. Anand Ranganathan

## Skill Development Program on Azure Fundamentals

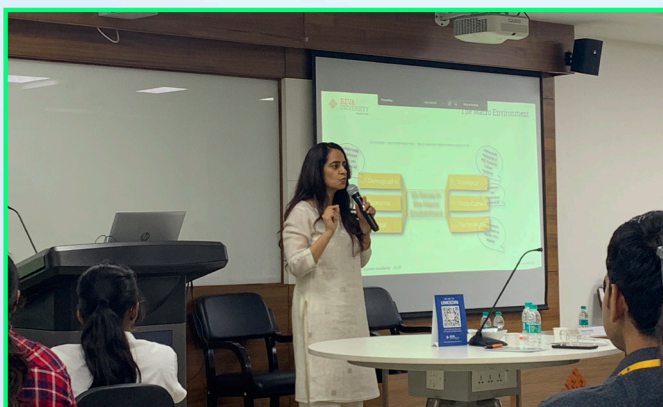

## Workshop on Histopathology and Biochemistry

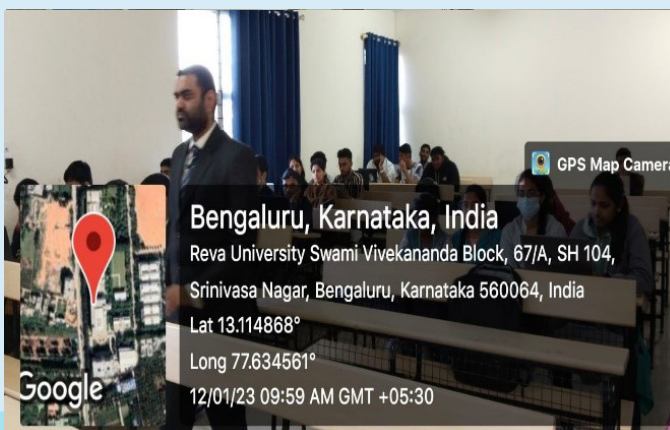
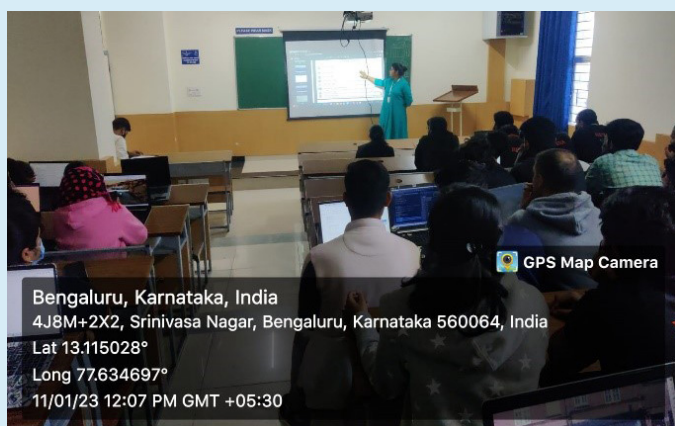

## Educational Extension Activity

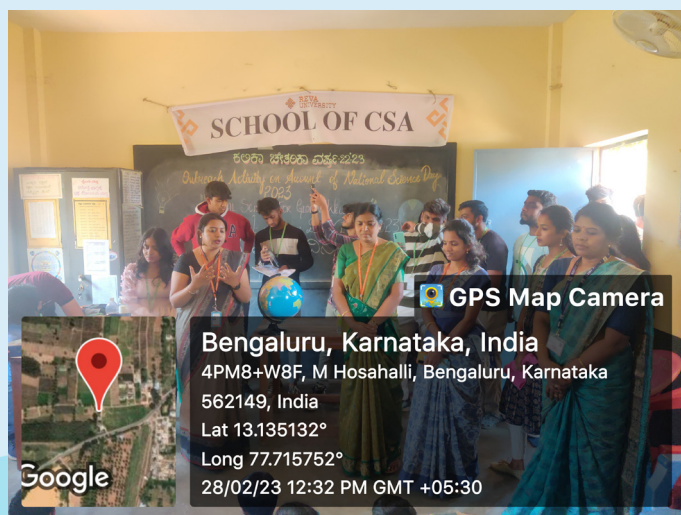

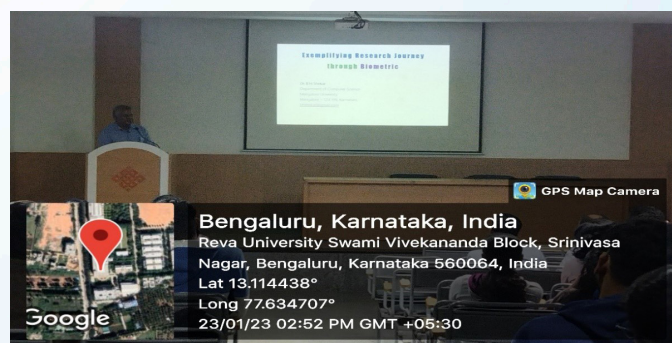


## Workshop on Healing and Meditation

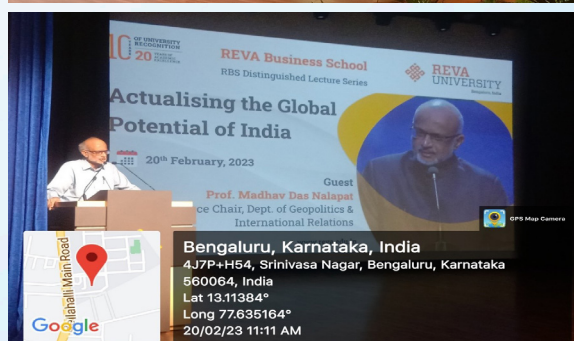
### **Expert Talk on Crisis Management in Events**

## Seminar on Experiential Journey in Dance

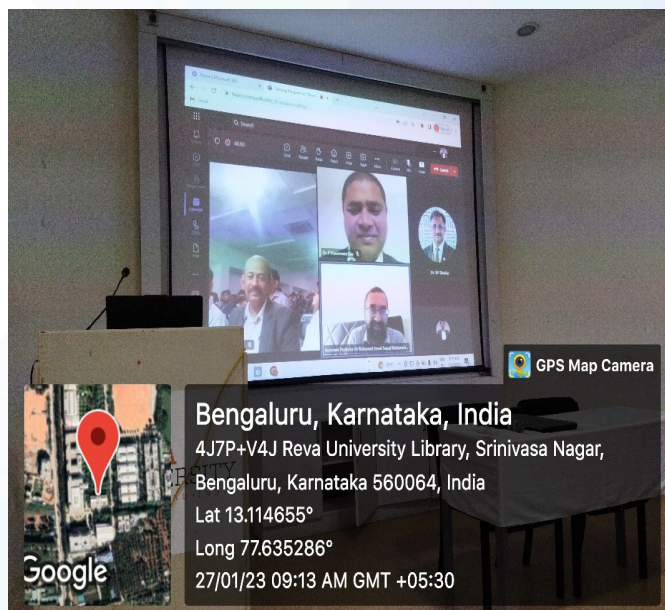

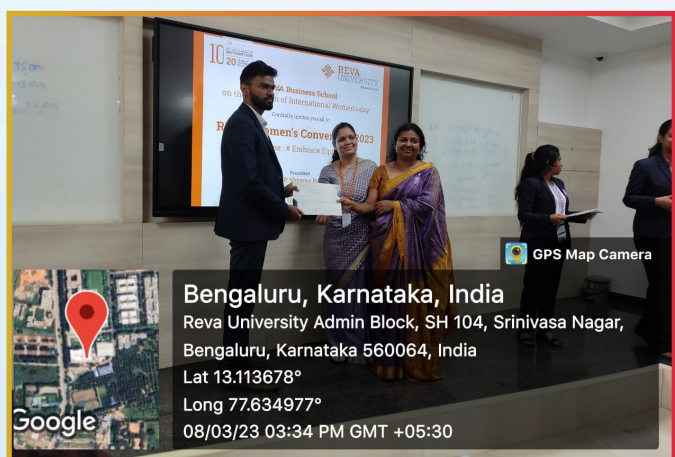
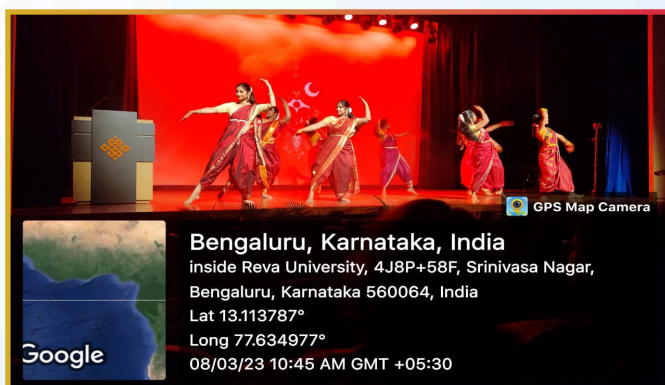
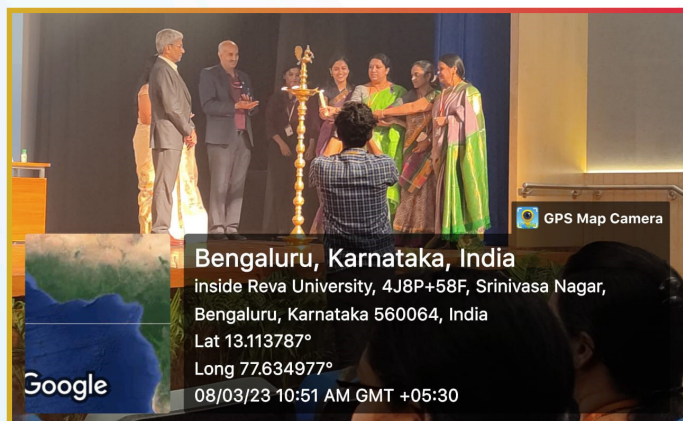
### **Extension Activity in association with Red Cross Society**

## Expert Talk on "Research Highlights on Nutritional and Health-Promoting Potential of Millets"

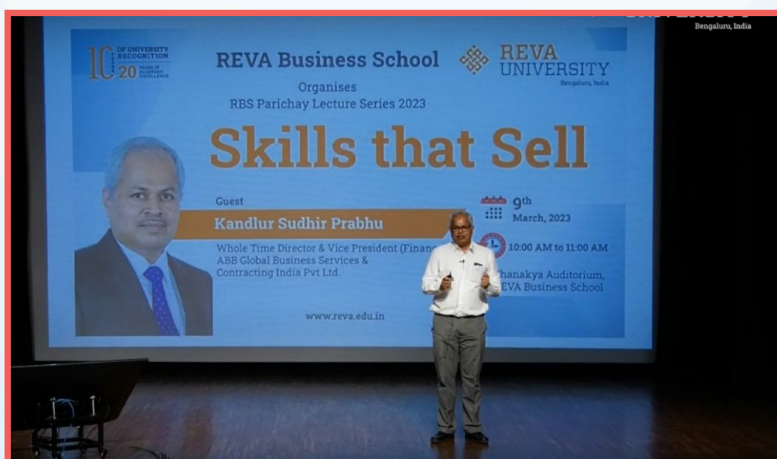

## Extension Activity

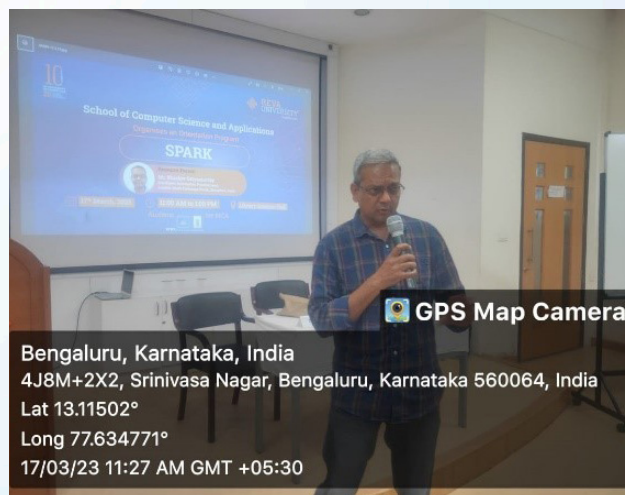
