KEY-HIGHLIGHTS:

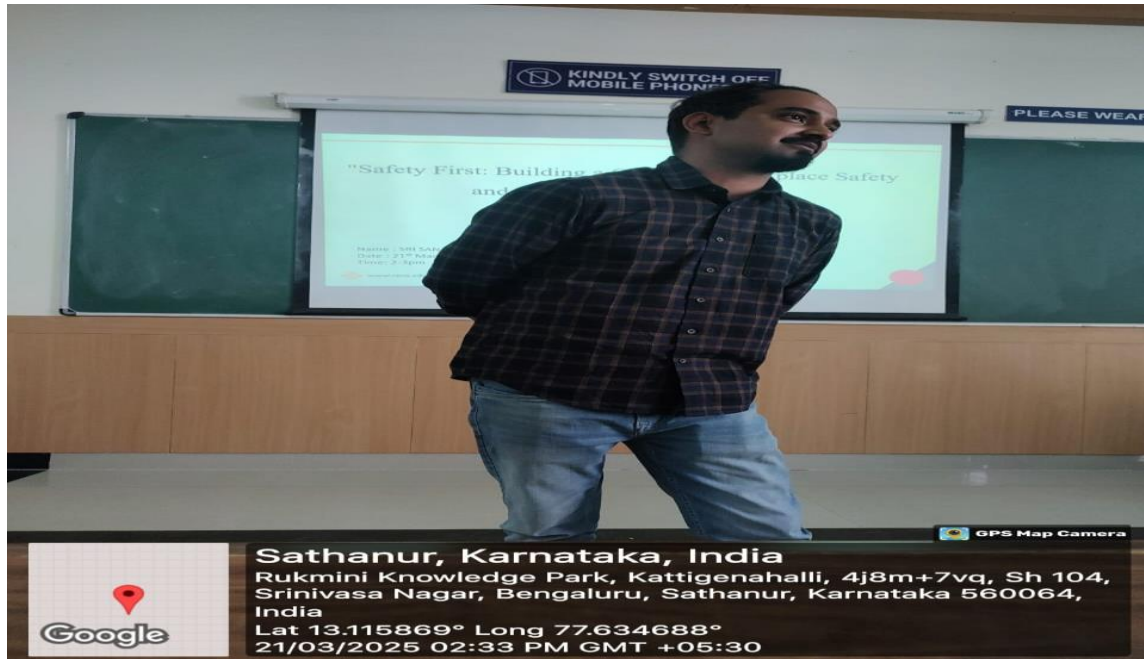

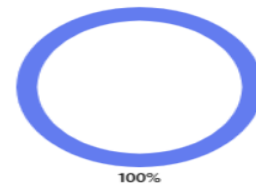
- The participants praised the talk for its practical relevance and the speaker's ability to relate academic concepts to real-world applications.

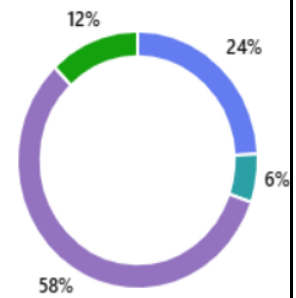

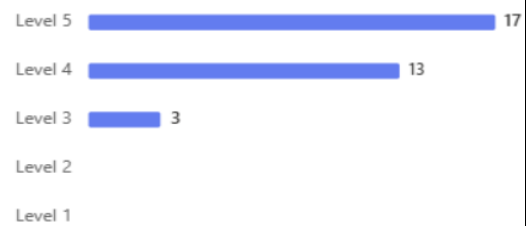
