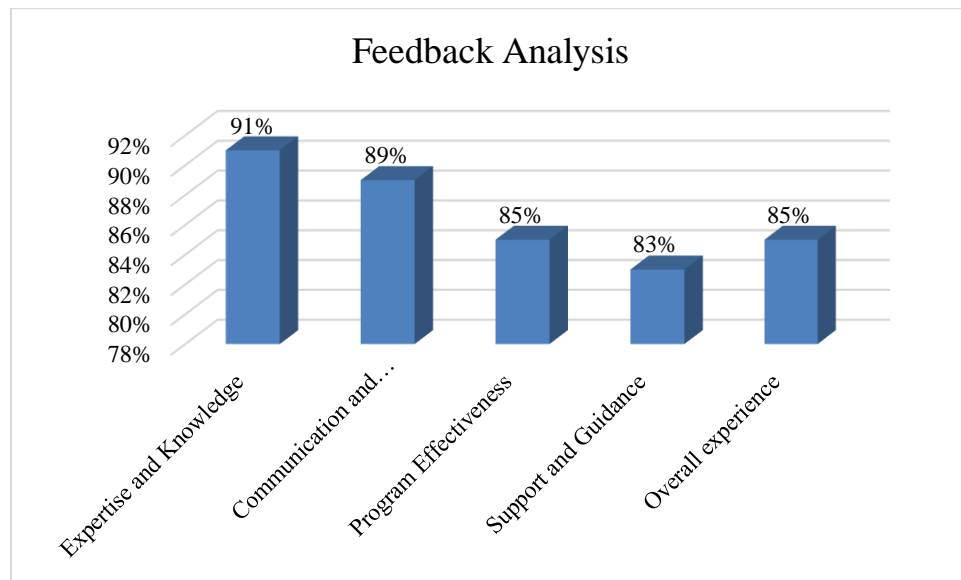
Vote of Thanks:

- Wanted more mentoring specific to finance and business analytics

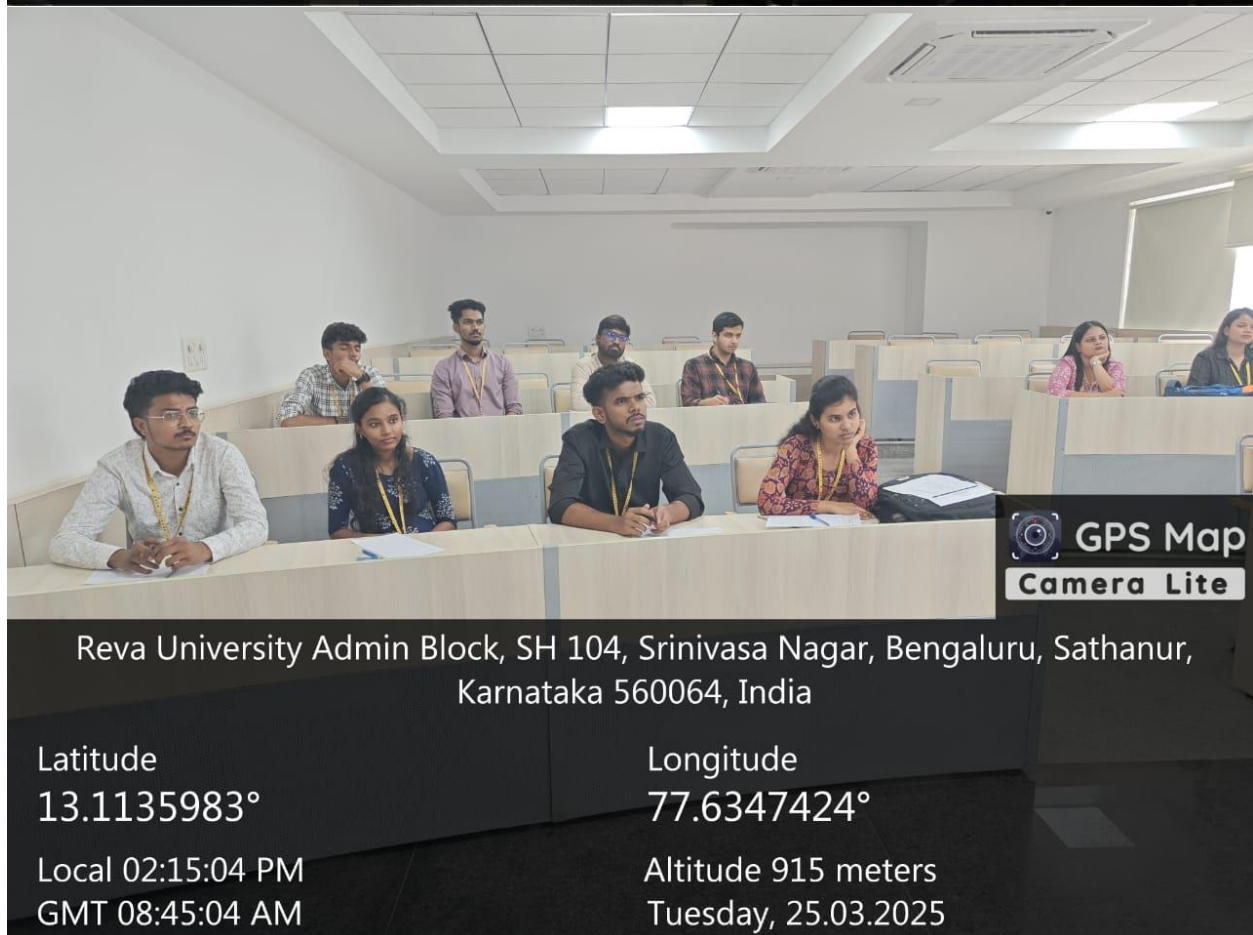
Actions Taken Report

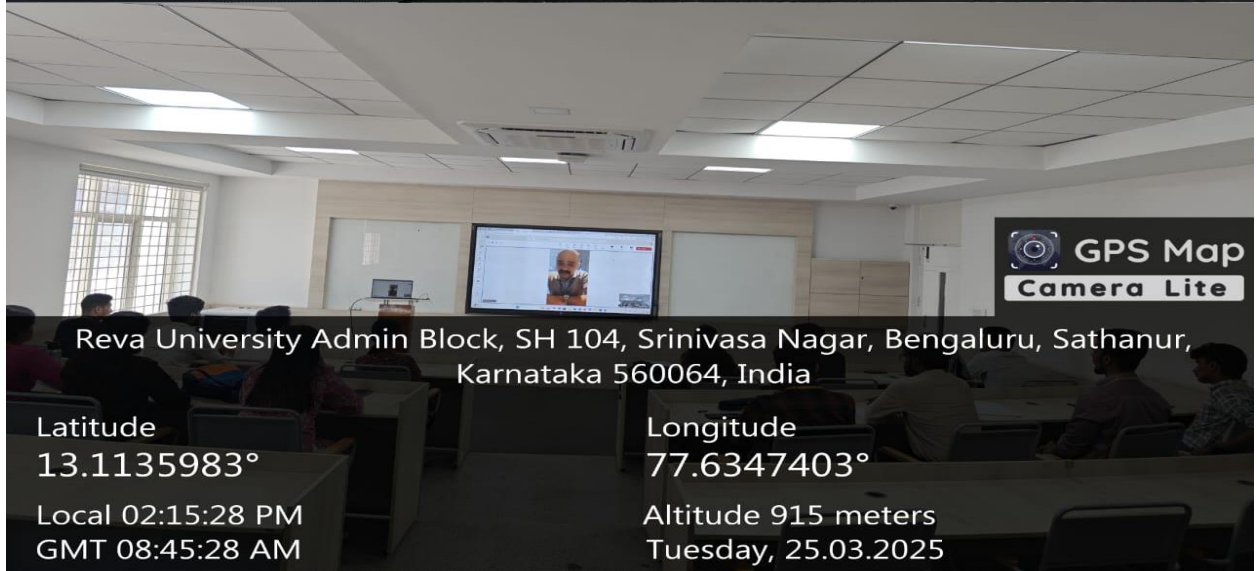
